

The above referenced project has been reviewed by the Community Assistance Program staff of this agency to identify potential areas that may contain prehistoric or historic archaeological materials (historic properties). The location of your project has been cross-checked with the state site files containing approximately 18,000 archaeological sites which are currently recorded for the state of Oklahoma. Site(s) are listed in your project area (**34MC623**) and based on the topographic and hydrologic setting of your project, archeological materials are likely to be encountered. **An archaeological field inspection is therefore considered necessary prior to project construction in order to identify significant archaeological resources that may exist in your area.** Please contact this office at (405) 325-7211 if you require additional information on this project.

This environmental review and evaluation is performed in order to locate, record, and preserve Oklahoma's prehistoric and historic cultural heritage in cooperation with the State Historic Preservation Office, Oklahoma Historical Society. In addition to our review comments, under 36CFR Part 800.3 you are reminded of your responsibility to consult with the appropriate Native American tribe/groups to identify any concerns they may have pertaining to this undertaking and potential impacts to properties of traditional and/or ceremonial value. 






Boundary For Environmental Review (Outlined in Red)
